4. CONTINGENCY: purely Zoom versions of Phoenix Singers / Levow an Bys

- a. To ensure sessions can continue if
live singing becomes impossible
(through change to national / local
or venue guidelines) Zoom
versions of No. 1 and 2 will be
offered . *£5 per session, to be
booked and paid in advance.

NB for all 'in person' sessions, participants will be
limited in number to make the venue C-19 secure;
places must be booked and paid for in advance*; all
participants must agree to abide by C-19 risk
reduction arrangements as specified when booking
(which could change at short notice due to
government guidelines and / or venue conditions).
Also - Sessions could also be cancelled at short notice
for reasons outside our control in which case an
online replacement session will be offered whenever
possible.

Musicianship: Bronze Level 1

Always wanted to learn to read music / sight sing and develop your inner musician?

Why not start the exciting journey this autumn?

Studying musicianship enables you to learn skills to help you read music, sing in tune, stay in time and hold your part when singing. It's a practical, structured course which is challenging, fun and satisfying as you find yourself making progress.

Bronze Level 1 Musicianship is part of a 6-part programme developed by the National Youth Choir of Scotland. Successful completion of the final level (Gold 2) being equivalent to ABRSM Grade 5 (and you get the bonus of being able to sight sing!). 16 of your fellow singers have completed all 6 Musicianship levels over the last few years - with great results and great feedback.

I am now planning to start the series again with the pilot of an online course for **Bronze Level 1** delivered over Zoom. We will have 8 workshop sessions on a **Tuesday mornings** spread out throughout the term. Some of the Musicianship 'graduates' will join us as mentors and there will be video and audio files to support your learning available on my web site.
